**Parents (and other appropriate adults)...**

Registration requires you to surrender many of your rights at law as they affect both you and your child. We're not happy with that but it's a fact of life. See "Notice regarding Insurance Cover" below. If you're unhappy with this situation, your only option is {sadly} to refuse to register your child.

- (1) I understand that the activities in which my child may be involved may include games, training sessions, fundraising activities, media events, tournaments, gala days and any other activity allied with MiniBall.
- (2) I acknowledge a responsibility to ensure that my child's health and general fitness are appropriate to the activities involved, including both training and playing.
- (3) I authorise The League or its officials to procure medical care for my child should the need arise, and to do so in my stead without the right to hold The League or its officials culpable for the results of such care if found to be inadequate or negligent.
- (4) Upon request, I will provide a Birth Certificate or other documentation to prove my child's birth date.
- (5) I will remit any moneys assessed by The League as payable in respect of my child's participation in any activities controlled by The League.

- (6) I will return, upon request, any equipment provided on loan to my child by The League, or alternately will provide compensation for the loss of any such items.
- (7) I will indemnify The League and Affiliated Clubs jointly and severally against all claims, demands, suits and any actions whatsoever brought by any person against The League or an Affiliated Club arising from loss, damage or injury to any person resulting from my child's participation in any activity organised by The League or an Affiliated Club.
- (8) I warrant that my behaviour at League activities, and that of other family members and friends, will be non-confrontational, benign and unlikely to bring the game into disrepute.
- (9) I have been given the time and opportunity to read and understand this document before assenting to this Agreement.

**NOTICE REGARDING PUBLISHING OF YOUR CHILD'S IMAGE ON THE INTERNET**

From time to time, we may take pictures of MiniBall activities to post on our website. This is usually quite harmless, as we will **never ever** include a child's name or any other details that would personally identify them. However, we acknowledge that you may not want your child's image published at all, for all sorts of reasons. If this is the case, please say so on the front of this form in the space provided. Also, accidents do happen:- should you find an inadvertently published photo that you want removed, please contact a MiniBall Official and we will immediately withdraw it.

**PRIVACY STATEMENT**

Your privacy is respected by us. The information you provide will be used to provide services for you and for the purposes of registration and communication. It may be passed onto the NSW Baseball League (NSWBL) the Australian Baseball Federation (ABF) and to the ABF's insurer. Your information may also be shared with organisations associated with the sport of Baseball, including but not limited to the Australian Sports Commission and Australian Sports Drug Agency. HJBA, NSWBL and the ABF may at times ascertain whether or not we have services or products which may foreseeably meet your needs and may notify you about these. We will not however, share your personal contact details with any third party for their commercial use. If you do not provide the information we may not be able to register you as a member. We, HJBA, NSWBL and the ABF comply with the Privacy Act with respect to the collection, storage and security of your personal details. If you have any privacy concerns or would like to verify any information we hold about you, please contact the President of HJBA or the privacy officers at NSWBL or the ABF, as appropriate.

**REFUND POLICY**

Once fees have been paid for a term, they are non-refundable. However, we understand that absences are sometimes unavoidable, and therefore we will upon request issue a credit note for unused sessions at the rate of \$4.00 per session. This can be used to reduce the fee payable for a future term, within 12 months of your original registration. It is transferrable, so you can also give (or even "sell") it to a friend or sibling for the same purpose.

Items in the Getting Started Pack may be returned for a refund only if in perfect condition, ready to be issued to somebody else, and within 3 weeks of the start of term.

**CASUAL SUBTITUTE PLAYERS**

Should your child be unable to attend one or more sessions, but wishes to continue in the programme, you are welcome to nominate somebody else to take their place for those sessions, at no additional charge. The "somebody else" should be a child who would otherwise qualify to play if they were registered, and their parent/carer will be required to agree to the same conditions for participation as you have.
